# Neurolink Process and Emotional Symbolism

## Program

Intended for: Qualified manual therapists and osteopaths

Daily training hours: 8h

Training time: 2 x 6 days (2 x 48h i.e. 96h)

The 2 modules are spaced at least 3 months apart to enable students to practice and appropriate the techniques in the office. During this period, participants are supervised and monitored (monthly zoom, answers to questions, telephone exchanges).

The Neurolink team is in regular contact with the students to adjust the work if necessary, and to answer any questions they may have.

Prerequisites: necessary to harmonize students' knowledge. As soon as they register, participants have access to courses (written, audio, video) via their space on the Neurolink website. Our team ensures that the prerequisites are fully assimilated before the start of the course.



# Seminar 1

## Tissue approach

1. Tissue principles - fascia, dysfunctions, micro-movements
2. Researching tissue levels - from skin to bone
3. Listening to tissue - tissue movement
4. Correction of dysfunctions
5. Cranium - Primary Respiratory Mechanism (PRM), Intracranial Membranes, Tests and Corrections

## Anatomy and physiology of emotion

1. Nervous system and limbic structures
2. Hormonal system

## Emotion in tissues

1. Emotion - restriction of mobility and postural/hormonal/behavioral adaptation...
2. Principles and conditions of somatization
3. Fascial tensions - T4 zone (sternal zone)

## Plateau test and energetic approach

1. Body-feeling exercises, alone and in pairs, and principles of unconscious communication - postures, attitudes
2. Testing areas of tension with the feet, testing the patient's rhythm (slow, medium, fast), synchronizing with the patient's rhythm, first reading

## Emotions and organs

1. Table of correspondences between emotions and viscera and pathophysiological consequences of emotional memories (somatization)
2. Finding and correcting somatization
3. Recoil - theory and practice

## Cranial liberation

1. Interpretation of cranial tests (sleep quality, nervous rhythm, etc.)
2. Liberation in the 3 planes/3 techniques - theory and practice

## Vascular

1. Anatomy and location of the vascular system
2. Recoil release

## Lines

1. Principle of lines
2. Practice

## Bio-psychosocial implications of emotional mechanisms and emotional symbolism

1. Principle of pathology and disorder development
2. Analysis of symptoms and symbolisms

## Energy principle

1. Energy forces and body adaptations - somatization compensation
2. Energy rhythms (round, MRP, lymphatic) - theory and practice
3. Anatomy and physiology of the energy system
4. Magnetic field and perception of space in 3 dimensions - theory and practice

## Emotional patterns of birth

1. Principle and anatomy - embryology
2. The 4 emotional patterns and variations in information integration (fight, acceptance or flight). Description and pathophysiological consequences (problems of perception of time, space and pressure).
3. Test, from the sternum, of the level of the round and test of the patient's energy rhythm.
4. Induction of the round - modification of the patient's schema

## Transgenerational memories

1. Theory
2. Emotional issues as a function of location
3. Tests and corrections

## Emotional synthesis

1. Theory of emotional synthesis
2. Emotional problems, depending on location along the spine
3. Tests and corrections

## Patient balance at the end of treatment

1. Vascular recoils and artery principles
2. Lymphatic recoils
3. Lines and extensions

## Biopsychosocial implications of the emotional mechanisms discussed

1. Global behavioral pattern based on different emotional memories
2. Principle of emotional architecture - the hierarchy of emotions
